- **1.** Read and discuss the following Bible verses.
  - **a.** Philippians 2:14
  - **b.** John 15:12
  - **c.** Hebrews 13:16
  - **d.** Galatians 6:9
- **2.** Who is a family helper?
- **3.** Discuss things you can do to be a family helper.
- **4.** Keep a log for three weeks listing how you have been a helper.
  - **a.** Each week discuss with your mentor the progress you have made that week.
  - **b.** Discuss the ways you have helped and which was your favorite.
  - c. Discuss what ways you could have helped differently.
- **5.** Make a thank you card/note for a family member to thank them for everything they do to be a family helper.

## Helps

- **1.** After reading each verse, ask the children for examples of how they can apply the verses in their lives.
- **2.** Show pictures of family members doing different activities and have the children explain why the person is a family helper. Your public library or the internet is a great resource for family helper pictures or you could take pictures of the Adventures and their families doing helpful activities.
- **3.** Have the children draw an activity or action (being agreeable or cheerful) from a container. Then have them act out the activity or action for the other children to guess.
