





Chapter 1

The Triday it all Began!

This was not how I was supposed to spend my Friday evening!

Let's rewind to a couple of weeks before this night. As a musician my normal routine included listening to music of some sort. This time a popular gospel song which spoke about trusting God was the praise of choice. I don't know if you are like me, but there are times when I keep one song which speaks to my heart, on repeat. For as long as it takes to filter through my heart. This was happening for those weeks leading up to that dreaded day. The entire song is powerful but these specific question and answer responses were what stuck in my head.

What was particular about this time were the questions the intro of the song asked. Deep inside I felt like it was an alter call or recommitment of sorts. I could not explain it then but my soul was drawn to li experiencing this song over and over again for weeks. The beginning of the song asked specific "what if" questions which challenged the listener to look at possible scenarios, then determine if

they would still trust God through it. Situations such as death of a loved one, abandonment, loss of love, hurts, pains, tears, fears, and failures. It also dared to have the listener decide if they will trust God, even when He is not felt near, is silent, or does not answer when He is called. As you can imagine, saying yes to all of these questions feel like it will take a huge amount of faith. I did not know it then but that was the point.

On this Friday, I was supposed to speak at one of the faith assemblies I attended for their Women's Ministry/Prayer event. I don't remember what I had prepared to say, but it sure doesn't matter now. I never made it to the service because as I prepared for the event, time stood still when I bent over to pull up my skirt. I felt a sharp pain and could not feel my legs. What replaced that feeling was excruciating pain and a sense that something was horribly wrong. I was taken in the hospital and while on that stretcher, tears streamed down my cheeks.

Every emotion filled my heart. I kept replaying my movements and wondering if I did something wrong or made a move too quick or too slow but all I kept coming up with was the pain was greater than recalling the events. Miraculously, the Holy Spirit pierced through the pain and anxiety and just like a DJ, he replayed the song and more specifically the questions for me. The streams of "What ifs...will you trust me?" flooded my mind. Believe me when I tell you that it took every fiber of my soul to

call my mind to answer the Holy Spirit. I closed my eyes, grabbed a hold of the cold, steel rail of the stretcher and through the stream of tears which seemed to overflow the more I squeezed my eyes, I whimpered yes, yes I will trust you, I need you to rescue me!

Two months later I found myself facing ongoing nerve damage from a disk in my lower spine popping out on both sides and cutting those nerves. I was losing the use of some of my faculties, my speech was slurred, my left arm growing limp and other complications arising from this spinal injury. My surgeon had resisted my pleas for surgery because he wanted my body to do all that it could have done first and then he would operate. His reasoning was that I would have a better chance of bouncing back quickly from surgery if it was the last resort.

Was I praying during this time? Absolutely! Was I asking God for the rescue which he promised me? Absolutely! Did I sense it was near? Absolutely not! Did I trust Him? Absolutely! Was this trust going to transform me? I didn't know fully then but I absolutely had to put my life in His hands! There was no other place to go. I knew that only a miracle making God would rescue me from this crisis.
