Think, Talk, Testify: Unpacking the Biblical Truth about Hellfire

1. Hellfire: A Place of Destruction, Not Eternal Torment

Read Malachi 4:1-3. Hellfire is not about eternal torture, but complete destruction of sin and those who reject God's grace.

Example: Like a fire that consumes garbage, hellfire serves a purpose and doesn't burn endlessly.

2. Understanding the Finality of Hellfire

Read Revelation 20:14-15. The "second death" is a permanent end for those who reject God, not ongoing torment.

Example: Think of it as a final court verdict—once executed, it's done.

3. God's Heart: Not Willing that Any Should Perish

Read 2 Peter 3:9. God's desire is for everyone to be saved, but hellfire is the outcome for those who choose to reject Him.

Example: Like a parent disciplining out of love, God's judgment is just, not vindictive.

Pray for wisdom and understanding as we explore God's justice and mercy. Ask for clarity and courage to share His love with others.

Read Ezekiel 18:23



The End of Sin, Not People

Reflect on Ezekiel 18:23, which shows that God takes no pleasure in the death of the wicked. Hellfire is not eternal suffering but the end of sin, allowing creation to be restored.

BIBLE STUDY QUESTIONS

1. What do Malachi 4:1-3 and Revelation 20:14-15 teach us about the nature of hellfire?
2. How does understanding hellfire as destruction rather than torment change your view of God's character?
3. Why is it important to know that God's heart desires all to be saved (2 Peter 3:9)?
4. How can this understanding help us share God's message of salvation?

PERSONAL APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. Have you ever struggled with the concept of hellfire? How does this lesson help you reconcile the idea of a loving God with final judgment?
2. How can understanding hellfire motivate you to share God's love with others?
3. How can this understanding of hellfire bring peace to your perspective of God's plan?
4. How can you help others who may have misconceptions about hellfire?
